Access to Records

Newhall surgery takes patient confidentiality very seriously. We strive to ensure your information is kept confidential and secure at all times.

However we appreciate that there are occasions due to various constraints it is useful for you to nominate a representative who has access to your data.

We have 2 levels of access at the surgery Basic and Enhanced. The full details of which are on the reverse of this form.

How does it work?

You would need to complete this form giving consent for your nominated representative to have your preferred level of access.

Your representative then also needs to fill in their details confirming they are happy to be your representative.

We will then add to your records that you have consented for this person to have access to a certain level of information. If your representative is registered here this will also be added to their record. This gives a complete picture of who has access to what record.

Can I change or stop my representative having access?

Yes you can remove your representative or change their access at any time. You would need to inform the surgery as soon as possible and fill out an Access Removal Form.

Please remember it is your responsibility to do this, the surgery will not prompt or remind you to review your representatives or levels of access.

If you require any further information regarding access please speak to one of the team members who will be happy to go through this with you in further detail.
